- According to the OSHA Federal Guidelines, employees are required to be trained to use fire extinguishers and other safety procedures upon employment and annually thereafter.
- Additionally, many insurance companies require that employees be trained in fire extinguisher usage.

- All classes include the operation of a unit by each student to comply with OSHA.

TRAIN THE TRAINER

This is an extensive one-day course that certifies the student as a fire instructor for 3 years. This session includes: lesson plans, power point programs, classroom and hands on training, evaluations, and lunch at our training facility. Class size is limited to 8 people. Training can also be conducted at your facility. Additional charges apply.

SPECIALIZED FIRE TRAINING

Training designed to fit your needs such as systems training, combined extinguisher and systems training, revolving training and team firefighting.

CONTRACT FIRE TRAINING

This session includes: classroom and live fire training or Simulator training, permits, handouts, certificates, and extinguishers provided for 25 people. Must pay for two years in advance. One class in 2017 and one in 2018.

MODIFIED CLASSROOM FIRE TRAINING Plus nitrogen only recharges

This classroom presentation includes a power point presentation, a verbal presentation from a certified instructor, question/answer sessions, full color handouts, and fire training certificates. Each student operates an extinguisher. Class includes up to 50 people. Nitrogen recharges are \$5.00 each.

CLASSROOM AND LIVE FIRE TRAINING Plus recharges and permit if needed

This session combines both the classroom and live fire training sessions. The certificates provided for this session signify both classroom and live fire training. Class includes up to 50 people.

NEW... RESTAURANT SYSTEM & FIRE EXTINGUISHER FAMILIARIZATION

Training session that covers the automatic and manual operation of the kitchen system and fire extinguisher using the simulator. In accordance with OSHA each student must demonstrate the ability to operate a fire extinguisher. Up to 25 students

LIVE FIRE TRAINING

Plus recharges and permit if needed

This session includes a short pre-brief and hands on training fighting a Class B fire. We will also provide instructional pamphlet, and fire training certificates. Class includes up to 50 people.

LASER SIMULATOR TRAINING

This session includes your choice of classroom training or a short pre-brief. Each student combats a simulated fire on a diamond screen using a laser extinguisher. Great for companies in congested areas and hospitals. Instructional pamphlets and training certificates are included.
